Relationship to Nominee:

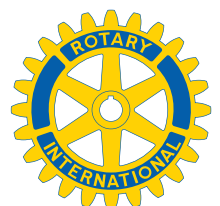
- What is the relationship between the nominator and the young person who is being nominated?
- How was the nominator involved with the nominee's service activity? (Define the nominator's role in the service)

Description of service project:

- What was the need addressed by this nominee's project?
- What were the verifiable results of the nominee's service project? (What significant event occurred that the nominee was responsible for and how many people benefited or were positively impacted?)
- Define the time frame in which the service was initiated and completed. (If the activity is ongoing, please explain the projected time of completion.)
- Did the nominee raise funds for the activity? If so, what was the amount?

Questions about the of nominee:

- What was the nominee's specific leadership role in the service activity? (In order to meet the service need, what did the nominee do that was extraordinary?)
- Was s/he clearly the initiator of this project? Explain.
- What obstacles and/or challenges did the nominee overcome while leading this service project?
- What are his/her greatest strengths?
